This will provide a pull off for cars to stop and read the marker and it will be safe from plows.

Joyce reported that there will be a brief dedication ceremony, of the plaques that have been placed on town owned buildings, on August 4th, Monday, @7:00pm at the Bakery Building. It will be brief and we will provide cold drinks and baked goods.

We are waiting for word from the State of NH on the placement of a bench on the triangle at the south end of Main St. Dr. Caloras has decided to wait on a bench until he leases the building. The Unitarian church has voted for the bench, we are waiting to speak to them on where it will be placed.
