

Town of Charlestown Transfer Station

Recyclable Items: (NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE)

Glass – bottles and jars (no tops or lids)

Paper – newspaper, magazines, shredded paper, cereal boxes, food boxes (pasta, snack cakes, etc.), egg cartons, paper towel and toilet paper rolls, soda and beer boxes, etc. – **no wet or soiled items**

Co-mingle - #1 and 2 plastic only (found on a triangle at the bottom of the container) and the neck must be smaller than the bottom of the container, tin cans (soup, veggie, fruit, tuna, etc.) – **no toys, flower pots, gas cans, water cans, etc.**

Cardboard – corrugated only – must be clean and flattened – **no wet or soiled items**

Aluminum Cans – soda and beer

Metal – washers, dryers, vacuums, stoves, irons, vcr's, bicycles, lawn mowers, etc.

Batteries – car, tractor, and rechargeable

Waste Oil – left in 1 gallon jugs only

Reuse Hut – clothes and books only – **must be clean and usable**

Items with a disposal fee:

Demo – plywood, shingles, finished or treated lumber, chipboard, furniture, hoses, plastic toys, coolers, tarps, big rolls of plastic, car parts, large amounts of Styrofoam, etc. – **anything under 20 pounds is a \$2.00 minimum and anything over 20 pounds is 6½¢ per pound on the scale**

Porcelain and Glass – toilets, sinks, mirrors, window or auto glass, plexiglass, dishes, etc. - **anything under 20 pounds is a \$2.00 minimum and anything over 20 pounds is 6½¢ per pound on the scale**

Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners - \$15.00

Microwave Ovens - \$10.00

Computers – CPU, monitor, keyboard, printer - \$5.00 each or \$10.00 for a set

Televisions – 19” or less - \$2.00 ----- anything over 19” must get on the scale

Propane Tanks - \$2.00

Helium Tanks - \$5.00

Tires – Auto without a rim - \$2.75 on a rim - \$3.75
Over 18” (heavy truck and tractor) - \$50.00

Fluorescent Light Tubes - 25¢ a foot

Other Items:

Burn Pit – may only have clean, unfinished/untreated wood/lumber (this includes brush and tree limbs less than 5 inches in diameter)

Compost – leaves, pine needles, grass clippings, and garden waste – no Christmas trees, brush, sticks, tree limbs (these should be placed in the Burn Pit)

Compost when available can be purchased by the backhoe bucket load at the following prices:
