## RSA 91-A:3 II \*\* Indicate Item(s)

- (a) <u>DISMISSAL, PROMOTION, COMPENSATION, DISCIPLINE or</u> <u>INVESTIGATION</u> of any public employee; unless employee has a right to a meeting and requests that the meeting be open);
- (b) <u>HIRING</u> of any public employee:
- (c) Adversely affect <u>REPUTATION</u> of any person other than a member of the Board itself (including applications for assistance, tax abatement or waiver of fees/fines (*if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant*):
- (d) <u>ACQUISITION, SALE or LEASE OF REAL or PERSONAL</u> <u>PROPERTY</u> which, if discussed in public, might benefit those with interests adverse to the general community;
- (e) <u>PENDING CLAIMS OR LITIGATION</u>, either filed or threatened in writing (not including tax abatement applications filed with any body or board);
- (i) Preparation, training and carrying out of <u>EMERGENCY FUNCTIONS</u> <u>INTENDED TO THWART TERRORISM</u> (i.e. a deliberate act intended to result in widespread or severe property damage, injury or loss of life);
- (1) <u>CONSIDERATION OF LEGAL ADVICE</u> provided by legal counsel, either in writing or orally, to one or more members of the public body, even where legal counsel is not present.
