RSA 91-A:3 II ** Indicate Item(s)

- (a) <u>DISMISSAL</u>, <u>PROMOTION</u>, <u>COMPENSATION</u>, <u>DISCIPLINE</u> or <u>INVESTIGATION</u> of any public employee; unless employee has a right to a meeting and requests that the meeting be open); (b) <u>HIRING</u> of any public employee:
- (c) Adversely affect <u>REPUTATION</u> of any person other than a member of the Board itself (including applications for assistance, tax abatement or waiver of fees/fines (if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant):
- (d)<u>ACQUISITION</u>, SALE or LEASE OF REAL or PERSONAL PROPERTY which, if discussed in public, might benefit those with interests adverse to the general community;
- (e) <u>PENDING CLAIMS OR LITIGATION</u>, either filed or threatened in writing (not including tax abatement applications filed with any body or board);
